



REGISTRATION FEE CLARIFICATION FOR NEIGHBOURING COMMUNITIES

Anyone is welcome to come to Hatchet Lake for the Conference, but please note, due to the high costs of hosting this program, only those participants who have paid the registration fee will have access to certain facilities and activities at this time. To clarify, we have outlined what will be available to the general public and what will be the benefits to paid registrants.

GENERAL PUBLIC

- No registration or payment is necessary
- Travel and accommodation is at own expense
- Access to the Culture Village and outdoor eating areas
- Access to all outdoor entertainment pavilion activities and performances and local events
- Restricted from entering conference facilities (Conference Session @ High School; Accommodations @ Elementary School) and participating in conference sessions

PAID REGISTRANTS

- Registration forms must be submitted; \$150 adult, \$75 youth under 18yrs
- All paid registrants will receive an accreditation tag to access all conference facilities
- Travel at own expense; Free Boat Shuttle from Barge Landing
- Accommodation available (Camping Village, School Dorms, Teacherage, Motel)
- Access to the Culture Village and outdoor eating areas; access to the indoor food services, refreshments and snacks
- Access and participation in all conference sessions, tours, tradeshow, entertainment and activities
- Receive a participant bag including conference souvenirs, program/agenda and other resource materials
