



Travel Options & Accommodation Info

Hatchet Lake is an isolated community on the eastern shore of Wollaston Lake in Northern Saskatchewan. In the summer, the community can be accessed by boat, barge or airplane. Please indicate your preferred travel and accommodation options on your registration form.



TRAVEL OPTION 1: DRIVING TO BARGE LANDING -BOAT SHUTTLE or BARGE TO WOLLASTON LAKE

Participants can drive on paved highway to as far as La Ronge. An all-season gravel road can be traveled to reach Barge Landing. Take caution as many large trucks also share this road.

Distances: Saskatoon to Prince Albert 136km
 Prince Albert to La Ronge 234km
 La Ronge to Barge Landing 418km

Boat Shuttle: Boat shuttles will be provided for ALL participants who require transportation from Barge Landing to Wollaston Lake. Shuttles will run from approximately 12:00noon to 8:00pm on August 19, returning the morning of August 23. A secure area at Barge Landing will be provided for you to park your vehicle for the duration of the conference. The boat shuttle takes approximately 45min.

Barge: Vehicles may be transported across the lake via Barge (approx.\$20 one way), there is limited space and participants are responsible for making their own arrangements by calling the Hatchet Lake Economic Development Office at (306) 633-2050.

TRAVEL OPTION 2: DRIVING TO LA RONGE -VAN SHUTTLE TO BARGE LANDING -BOAT SHUTTLE TO WOLLASTON LAKE

There are two vans available to shuttle participants from La Ronge to Barge Landing. Participants will then take a boat shuttle (see above) from Barge Landing to Wollaston Lake.

Depart La Ronge - 9am*, August 19 **Arrive** Barge Landing - 2pm*, August 19

Depart Barge Landing - 11am*, August 23 **Arrive** La Ronge - 4pm*, August 23

TRAVEL OPTION 3: DIRECT FLIGHTS TO WOLLASTON LAKE

Scheduled flights are available from Regina, Saskatoon, Prince Albert, La Ronge, and Fort McMurray.

ACCOMMODATION OPTION 1: CAMPING/TENTING:

All able bodied participants are encouraged to camp. A secure camping village will be set up in the elementary school grounds. Washroom and shower facilities will be available inside the school. Please contact the event coordinator if you need to borrow a tent.

ACCOMMODATION OPTION 2: SCHOOL DORM

Portable cots will be set up in classrooms inside the elementary school. Preference will be given to Elders and participants traveling in groups.

ACCOMMODATION OPTION 3: TEACHERAGE HOUSING

A limited number of 2 and 3 bedroom houses are available. Preference will be given to presenters and partner organizations.

ACCOMMODATION OPTION 4: MOTEL

A limited number of standard 2 bed motel rooms are available. Preference will be given to delegates and presenters.
